SUBJECT: CTD for CAP 103-10(I) -- P. L. 111-256 (Rosa's Law)

1. **SYNOPSIS:** Public Law 111-256 replaces the term 'mental retardation' with 'intellectual disability' effective 5 October 2010. The legislation applies to all federal laws and/or regulations including the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 references found in JTR (Vol. 2), Chapter 7, Part J. See the below hyperlink for more details:

The terms below are defined for this Part.

A. *****

B. *****

*C. Physical/Mental Impairment. "Physical/mental impairment" means:

1. Any physiological disorder/condition, cosmetic disfigurement, or anatomical loss affecting one or more of the following body systems; neurological, musculo-skeletal special sense organs, respiratory (including speech organs), cardiovascular, reproductive, digestive, genitourinary, hemic and lymphatic, skin, and endocrine; or
2. Any mental/psychological disorder, such as intellectual disability, organic brain syndrome, emotional/mental illness, and specific learning disabilities.
3. "Physical/mental impairment" also includes such diseases and conditions as cerebral palsy, epilepsy, muscular dystrophy, multiple sclerosis, cancer, heart disease, diabetes, intellectual disability, emotional illness, orthopedic, visual, speech, and hearing impairments, and similar diseases and conditions.
