SUBJECT: UTD/CTD for MAP 31-13(I)/CAP 33-13(I) -- Add Chief, National Guard Bureau to List of Dignitaries

1. **SYNOPSIS:** Adds Chief, National Guard Bureau to the JFTR/JTR list of dignitaries that may warrant AEA when a traveler is directed to travel with the dignitary. This item also corrects references in JFTR, pars. U4129-A and U4131-A.

JFTR REVISIONS

U4129-A:

A. General

4. A traveler must adhere to the prudent traveler rule for official travel funded by the GOV'T. See par. U2000

6. See par. U4129-F for multiple occupancy.

U4131-A:

A. General. An apartment, house, or recreational vehicle (includes a mobile home, a camper, a camping trailer, or self-propelled mobile recreational vehicle) leased or rented ICW official TDY qualifies as lodging. Par. U4129-F applies for multiple occupancy involving official travelers; par. U4129-G for lodging with a friend/relative at the friend's or relative's residence; and par. U4129-H for multiple lessees of rented/leased TDY lodging.

U4220-B:

B. Travel with Certain Dignitaries. Without further demonstration of unusual/extraordinary requirements AEA is authorized for a traveler who is directed to travel as part of the party of any of the following dignitaries. Also see Ch 7, Part U.

The Chief of Staff, U.S. Army; the Chief of Staff, U.S. Air Force; the Chief of Naval Operations; the Commandant, U.S. Marine Corps; the Commandant, U.S. Coast Guard; the Administrator, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration; the Surgeon General, U.S. Public Health Service, and the Chief, National Guard Bureau;
