SUBJECT: UTD/CTD for MAP 129-12(I)/CAP 112-12(I) -- Add SIM Cards to APP G Communication Services

<u>Communication Services.</u> GOV'T-owned/leased services should be used for official communications, but when GOV'T services are not available commercial communications services may be used. <i>Prepaid communication (i.e., prepaid phone cards, cell phones, subscriber identity module (SIM) cards) or in-flight communication services are not reimbursable unless the AO can determine they were used for official business.</i>		X		X
