I. GENERAL SOFTWARE UPDATE INFORMATION

- **Software Version Number:** 1.7.3.36
- **EWTS Release Date:** July 6, 2016
 - **Expected EWTS Downtime:** 6 hours, beginning at 2300 EST on July 6, 2016
- **DTS Release Date:** July 8, 2016
 - **Expected DTS Downtime:** 6 hours, beginning at 2300 EST on July 8, 2016

II. SUMMARY OF FUNCTIONALITY *(As of June 28, 2016)*

Over the next year, updates to the system's Java Framework will be implemented incrementally; first in EWTS, then in DTS. These updates will enhance technology to include 508 compliance, system stability, system security, and will allow the system to leverage new browser capabilities. Additional information on what is included in this iteration is in section IV below.

- In this maintenance release, the Java Framework updates made to EWTS will primarily affect the Read-Only Access (ROA) screens. This update consists of cosmetic changes (e.g. consistent font sizes, centering of appropriate columns, proper capitalization.)
- In this maintenance release, the Java Framework updates made to DTS will primarily affect the Official Travel - Others Document Listing screens. Specifically, the updates will:
 - Allow user to select the number of documents displayed (10, 25, 50 or 100 documents at a time)
 - Include pagination
 - Allow columns to be sorted bi-directionally
 - Allow inactive documents to be accessed using checkbox at bottom
 - Added a "sticky" settings feature for each user session for the reviewing officials. When an RO/AO changes the default sort/display settings in Route & Review, the system keeps those settings and returns them to the same list after working a document. This was implemented based upon user feedback.

IV. Frequently Asked Questions

1. What changes will appear on the traveler lookup screen within the Official Travel – Others tab?

- Two options will be available after selecting the **Official Travel – Others** tab: **Traveler Lookup & Cross-Org Doc Lookup**.




Figure 1: Official Travel – Others – Traveler Lookup

- After selecting the **Traveler Lookup** tab, fillable boxes will appear from left to right with Traveler Name, TANUM and SSN available to enter your search criteria. (See Figure 1)




Figure 3: ROA Search Screen




Figure 4: ROA Document List
