II. SUMMARY OF FUNCTIONALITY (As of August 31, 2017)

- This release continues the incremental implementation of updates to the system's Java Framework, first in EWTS, then in DTS. These updates enhance technology to include 508 compliance, system stability and security, and allow the system to leverage new browser capabilities.
- Includes new messages for the Non-DTS Entry Agent (NDEA) on the Stamp Process screen. (See Section V)
- Includes/resolves functionality content listed in section III.
- Includes/resolves infrastructure content listed in section IV.




