

**Monetary Allowance in Lieu of Transportation (MALT) for Permanent Duty Travel - Traveling by Privately Owned Vehicle (POV)
(JTR, par. 050203)**

Examples of Multiple Travelers Using the Same POV

If...	Then...
Two travelers married to each other and each on a PCS order travel together in one POV with their two children,	one traveler is paid MALT for the official distance and all reimbursable expenses.
Three unrelated travelers, each on a PCS order, travel together in one POV between two PDS locations,	the traveler receiving MALT for the official distance is reimbursed for all reimbursable expenses.
A Service member married to a civilian employee, each traveling on an order and eligible for travel and transportation allowances, and their child travel together in one POV,	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Only one traveler on official orders may receive MALT for the official distance.• Either the Service member or the civilian employee may submit all reimbursable expenses.
