

Temporary Lodging Allowance Special (TLA-S) Computation Examples

Description	Scenario
Special Event – One Room without Meal Preparation Facilities	A Service member with a spouse and two children under age 12 are due to arrive and occupy temporary lodging without meal preparation facilities. The room rate is anticipated to escalate above the locality per diem rate for part or all of the anticipated TLA period due to a national convention. The Service member requires one room to accommodate the family size.
Special Event – Two Rooms without Meal Preparation Facilities	A Service member with a spouse, one child under age 12 and one child over age 12 are due to arrive and occupy lodging without meal preparation facilities. The room rates are anticipated to escalate above the locality per diem rate for part or all of the anticipated TLA period due to an international sporting event. The Service member requires two rooms to accommodate the family size.
Special Event – Two Service Members in the Same Room without Meal Preparation Facilities	Two Service members, each under a PCS order to the same PDS OCONUS, are due to arrive and occupy temporary lodging without meal preparation facilities. The room rates are anticipated to escalate above the locality per diem rate for part or all of the anticipated TLA period due to a national holiday. The Service members intend to share a room.
Special Event – One Person (Effective for lodging prior to 1 October 2020)	A Service member without a dependent is due to arrive and occupy temporary lodging without meal preparation facilities. The room rate is anticipated to escalate above the locality per diem rate for part or all of the anticipated TLA period due to a national holiday.
Special Event – One Person (Effective for lodging on and after 1 October 2020)	A Service member without a dependent is due to arrive and occupy temporary lodging without meal preparation facilities. The room rate is anticipated to escalate above the locality per diem rate for part or all of the anticipated TLA period due to a national holiday.
